I can understand the split digraph rule. I can read and spell words using Term 1 phonemes/graphemes e.g. play, cloud, make, flute etc. I can correctly make and spell 'plurals' by adding -s and -es when there is no change to the root word e.g., make – makes. I can read and spell most words with the suffixes -ing, -ed, -est, -er. I can read simple sentences by decoding words using the phonemes taught. I can write simple captions and sentences using the graphemes taught. I can read and spell Set 4 & 5 high frequency and common exception words. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can recognise and say all Term 2 phonemes/grapheme listed on Progression Map. I can find and/or write from memory all Term 2 graphemes on Progression Map. I can read and spell words using Term 2 phonemes/graphemes above e.g. tied, happy, statue etc. I can use alternative ways of pronouncing and representing the long vowel phonemes. I can read and spell familiar words without blending and segmenting. I can read simple sentences by decoding words using the phonemes taught. I can write simple sentences using the graphemes taught. I can use the spelling rule to spell words with k. I can read and spell words with the prefix un-. I can read and spell Set 6 high frequency and common exception words. 			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can recognise and say all Term 3 phonemes/grapheme listed on Progression Map. I can confidently apply my phonics knowledge and skills to reading and spelling unfamiliar words that are not completely decodable. I can read and spell phonically decodable two-syllable and three-syllable words. I can read and spell number words. I can read and spell common colour words. I can read and spell the months of the year. I can read and spell some simple contractions e.g. can't, it's, he'll, etc. I can read and spell Set 6 high frequency and common exception words.
