The programme focuses on nine key areas including **Energy, Water, Healthy Living, Litter, Biodiversity, Transport, School grounds, Waste and Global Citizenship.**

GREEN FLAG AWARD

Schools work through the Eco-Schools framework to achieve the **Eco-Schools Green Flag Award**, which is the highest level of recognition for environmental action and sustainability in schools.

How do we teach sustainability at Woodside Academy?

We have been actively working on environmental projects for many years, first participating in the Eco-Schools programme around **2015** and gradually expanding our eco initiatives. **We have proudly received the Green Flag Award multiple times**, recognising our ongoing commitment to sustainability.

Each year group focuses on specific environmental topics, although many activities overlap across the school. This year, our focus areas are Healthy Living, Energy, and Litter.

Our Eco Committee is made up of pupils from different year groups who help lead environmental projects across KS1 and KS2.



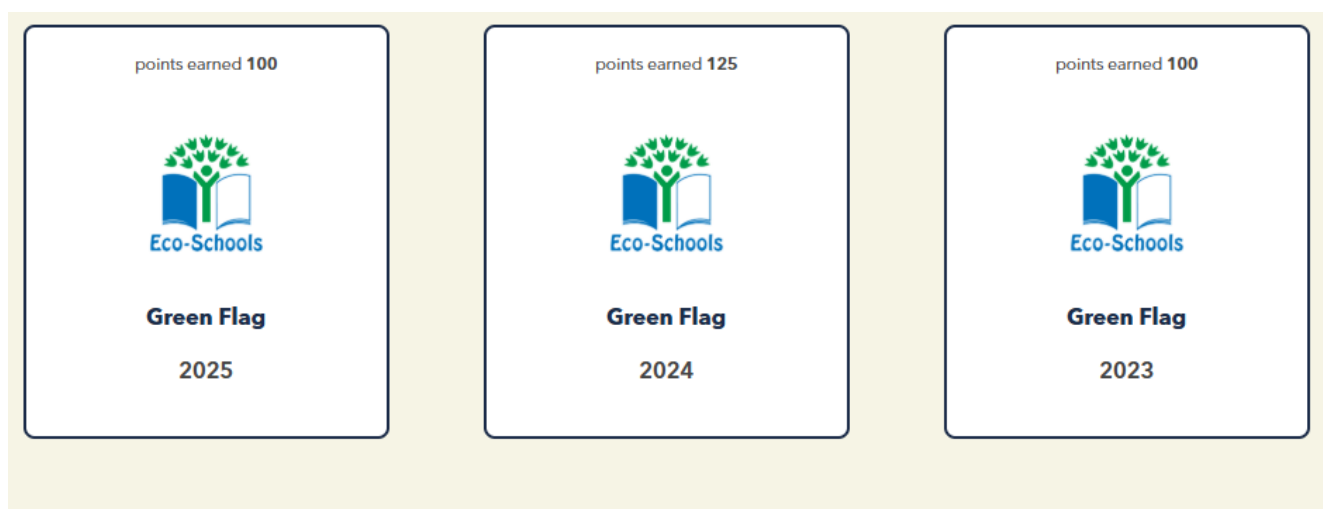
OUR ECO CAMPAIGNS
